- The Remote Group Program aims to connect **students from Palestine** (Al-Quds University Jerusalem), **Indonesia** (Sunan Kalijaga State Islamic University Yogyakarta) and **Germany** (Department for Arabic/Islamic Studies II, Goettingen)
- In a **group of 3** (one student from each country), students work on a **joint online project**
- **Topic:** Legal Pluralism - A Challenge for Human Rights? Perspectives from Palestine, Indonesia and Germany  
Participants will be provided with a basic outline and basic materials, based on which they develop the specific focus of their group project. The final topic of the group project will be determined by the students with support from the project team
- **The result:** a joint **presentation** (ca. 30 min.) at the **International Student Workshop on Nov. 4+5, 2021 in Yogyakarta** (Indonesia)

  - o **or** as part of a **conference trip to Yogyakarta (Nov. 1 – 8, 2021)**; for more information see separate Call/Ausschreibung
- **Who can apply from the University of Goettingen?**  
students of Arabic/Islamic Studies and students from other disciplines interested in the topic

  - o gaining experience by participating in an international project and preparing a joint presentation
  - o opportunity to participate as speaker in the International Student Workshop
  - o visiting Yogyakarta/Indonesia
  - o establishing contact to students from other countries

- **Project Framework:**
  - after participants have been selected, they will be introduced to each other and the project team
  - the final project topic will be defined according to interests and knowledge level of the participants
  - a short online workshop will provide input on how to prepare an academic presentation in an international and interdisciplinary environment
  - students are expected to organize their work independently (online meetings etc.)
  - preliminary and final presentation outlines have to be submitted during the initial and final project phase
  - project team will provide supervision and feedback
  - presentation on Nov. 4/5, 2021 (International Student Workshop)
